



- ▶ Export to shapefile, KML or other options.



FirstMap

▶ What it is

- Data Repository that can be used with ArcGIS or other GIS applications
- Map service provider
- Image service provider
- Resource to host applications
- Collection of data and services
- Made up of several components – infrastructure, web site, ArcGIS Online, Open Data


▶ What it isn't

- A replacement for ArcGIS Desktop
- Single application with all geospatial data for the State
- FirstMap is not the data owner
- Do not update the data, only publish it
- Repository for private sector data

- ▶ Most commonly used services include:
 - Boundaries – Municipalities & School districts
 - Society – Libraries & Schools
 - Basemap
 - 2012 Imagery
- ▶ Some services contain multiple features
- ▶ Most, but not all, services have feature services enabled.
- ▶ On average, FirstMap handles over 100,000 transactions a day
- ▶ Peak Usage Time is around 8am – 3pm






Sportsmen Against Hunger

During the deer seasons, the Delaware Sportsmen Against Hunger program encourages hunters to share their harvest by donating venison to Delawareans in need. The venison is distributed by DNREC's Division of Fish and Wildlife to more than 30 charitable organizations throughout the state.

The Delaware Sportsmen Against Hunger chapter was formed in 1992 by a coalition of sporting groups, with DNREC as the primary sponsor. In the 2013-2014 hunting season, 21,223 pounds of venison were donated and distributed, providing more than 100,000 meals for the hungry. Over the past 20 years, the program has provided more than 1.7 million meals for needy Delawareans.

Hunters who are not lucky enough to harvest a deer are encouraged to help by donating money to the project. Funds donated are used to pay for direct program expenses and to buy additional





Geocoder

↖ Geocoder

- ▶ Went live in June 2015.
- ▶ Composite geocoding service that checks:
 - Point Address Dataset (provided by each county)
 - Road Centerlines (provided by each county)
- ▶ Can be used for a single address, or a batch of multiple addresses.
- ▶ No fee for use of the geocoder!



- ▶ Went live in July 2015
- ▶ Most datasets are available through Open Data
- ▶ Availability depends on permission from the data owner
- ▶ Known issues with New Castle County Contours
- ▶ Downloading raster services, such as impervious surface, is a future enhancement.
- ▶ Larger datasets (i.e., NCC Contours) are available through Dropbox

← Cached Basemaps

↖ Cached Basemaps

- ▶ New cached basemaps have been added to FirstMap Private and Public
- ▶ Color – similar to Google maps style
- ▶ Light Gray – similar to the ESRI light gray canvas.
- ▶ Both are cached in State Plane and Web Mercator for optimum performance.
- ▶ Dark Gray coming soon

↖ Cached Basemaps

- ▶ Basemap symbology and labeling is optimized for each zoom level
- ▶ Includes the following layers:
 - Political boundaries
 - Surrounding States
 - Roads, including major routes
 - Major Rivers, Streams, Lakes, Ponds & Bays
 - Rail Lines
 - Public Protected Lands
 - Communities
 - Geographic Names
 - Elevation Contours


- ▶ Approximately 15 terabytes of space total, counting test and development.
- ▶ The ArcGIS Servers started out with 2 CPU's and 8Gb of RAM, and now have 4 CPU's with 32 Gb of RAM.
- ▶ Migrated public servers from HP SAN to Cisco UCS platform.
- ▶ Disk space has been increased on the database server and Oracle memory was increased.
- ▶ Upgraded from 10.2.1 to 10.2.2 and then to 10.3.1
- ▶ Removed cluster server

← Tips & Tricks

▶ Imagery resolution on export

- Keep the DPI set to 300
- For a pdf, set output quality between normal and best



▶ Dates Last Updated



- ArcGIS Online – date the AGOL item was updated, NOT the date of the last data update



- Services – dates are added to the descriptions manually.

📍 Tips & Tricks

- ▶ Downloading specific images through ArcMap
 - Exporting data from the data frame will download the tiles in the current extent
 - Limited to 20 tiles, or less than 2 Gb total



← Tips & Tricks

- ▶ Use ArcGIS Online Web Maps to create HTML code for embedding maps in your web sites
 - Save a web map, select share, then 'Embed in Website'
 - Map must be shared with 'Everyone' to enable this feature
